What to do after your interview with Nannies Who Care

Update your work history & be sure that your references have contact emails. Make sure your references are expecting the email from NWC.

Ensure there is no missing information on your application, make sure your contact information is accurate; phone number, address, etc.

Update your availability (This is how we contact you with available jobs!)

Check out our Job Board & notify the agency which jobs you are interested in - check back frequently as the job board changes often!

Complete your CPR Certification and provide a copy of your certificate to the agency & upload this to your Nanny profile under Documents.
